


How to Film Your “Dual-Role” Contest Skit

You will be playing two characters: **The PCS Interviewer (Role A)** and **YOU The Teacher (Role B)**. Choose the method below that fits your comfort level!


STEP 1: Choose Your Filming Style

Option 1: The Switch (Easiest)



- **Role A:** Look directly into the camera and record all your questions.
- **Role B:** Change your outfit, look into the camera and record all your answers.
- **The Goal:** You'll have one long video (or two clips) that you can “stitch” together in an app like **iMovie**, **Clipchamp**, or **Google Photos**. By cutting back and forth between your “two selves,” you create a fast-paced, engaging interview that feels like a real-time conversation.

Option 2: The Double (Side-by-Side)



- **The Setup:** Use a tripod or steady shelf - the camera must not move.
- **The Invisible Wall:** Imagine a line down the middle of your screen; do not cross it!
- **The Take:** Record one continuous video. **Sit on the Left for Role A**, walk off-screen to change, then **sit on the Right for Role B**.

STEP 2: Edit & Export

Educators can use any platform they prefer to create their video.

- **Length:** Your video should be **2 minutes or less**.
- **REQUIRED: The Contest Intro.** All entries must begin with the official “Be the First” title card.
 - **Download the files here.** (Available in .mp4 and .jpg).
 - **Select the correct ratio** (Portrait or Landscape) to match your video.
 - **Insert at 0:00.** Missing this step will result in disqualification.
- **Suggested Editing Apps:** **iMovie** on Apple devices. **Microsoft Clipchamp** on Windows devices. **Google Photos*** on Android devices.
 - *Note: Google Photos does not come preinstalled on Android devices. It is free to download via the Google Play store.*
- **Other Tools:** Social media platforms such as **Instagram** or **Facebook** have video editing options. You may also find and download other tools such as **CapCut** to edit your movie.
- **The Process:** Import the provided intro and your clips, use “Split”, “Trim” or “Overlay” to cut them, and line them up: **Intro** → **Question 1** → **Answer 1** → **Question 2** → **Answer 2**, etc..
- **Final Export:** Once finished, ensure your movie is exported in a video file format such as **.mp4** or **.mov**. The file size needs to be **under 50MB**.

STEP 3: Publish & Register

Enter the contest.

- **Publish:** Post your video publicly on social media and copy the post link.
- **Register:** Go to **offers.edventures.com/giveaway** to complete your contest registration where you’ll paste the link and upload your video.

Quick Tips:

Timing: Make sure to pause a second or two between questions and answers.

Teleprompter: Use a teleprompter tool to paste your script on screen so you can keep eye contact with the lens.
